5. Wabanaki Run will be on February 28. A ‘tramping party’ will be at 1 PM on the 27<sup>th</sup> to tramp down the path. Andy reports 184 mailings from previous year’s attendees will be mailed.
6. Dwight checking on “Reinhart 100” 3-D archery shoot. This is 100 targets of all sorts. It is a 2-day shoot, and we’d have to close all ranges for those two days, and perhaps a day or so on each side for set-up and tear-down of targets.
7. Put Primitive Biathlon (Wabanaki Run) on website, with search key words to find it.
8. Presentation of awards... Andy thinks we should be giving annual club awards out to winners at better event such as the annual meeting or annual banquet instead of just a regular director meeting. Will discuss more at the February meeting.
9. Pittman-Robinson Act Funds may be available from the state. Will have to find out more about this.
10. Need to think about someone to lead the Field Day setup for this year.
